BY THE COMMISSION: On July 1, 2022, Carolina Water Service, Inc. of North Carolina (CWSNC or the Company) filed an application with the Commission seeking authority to adjust and increase its rates for providing water and sewer utility service in all of its North Carolina service areas and for approval to establish and implement a three-year Water and Sewer Investment Plan (WSIP) pursuant to N.C. Gen. Stat. § 62-133.1B and Commission Rule R1-17A. On July 26, 2022, the Commission issued an Order Establishing General Rate Case and Suspending Rates, which declared this proceeding to be a general rate case and suspended the proposed rates for up to 270 days pursuant to N.C.G.S. § 62-134.

On September 2, 2022, the Commission issued an Order Scheduling Hearing, Establishing Intervention and Testimony Due Dates and Discovery Guidelines, and Requiring Notice (Scheduling Order) which, among other things, set this matter for expert witness hearing to begin on Monday, November 28, 2022, and acknowledged CWSNC's intent to implement temporary rates on an interim basis, under bond and subject to refund, for water and sewer utility service rendered on and after January 31, 2023.

The hearing was held as scheduled. Briefs and proposed orders are due on or before January 31, 2023.

On January 13, 2023, CWSNC filed Notice of Intent to Place Temporary Rates in Effect Subject to an Undertaking to Refund Pursuant to N.C. Gen. Stat. § 62-135 (Notice). In summary, the Notice states that CWSNC intends to exercise its statutory right to place into effect temporary rates pending a final order by the Commission approving permanent rates. CWSNC states that its proposed temporary rates will be implemented subject to an Undertaking to Refund and that by these rates, the Company will increase its current rates and charges for its CWSNC Uniform Water, CWSNC Uniform Sewer, Bradfield Farms/Fairfield Harbour/Treasure Cove Water, and Bradfield Farms/Fairfield Harbour

Sewer Rate Divisions by \$2,166,142, which represents temporary rate increases of 3.501%, 6.323%, 6.978% and 5.653%, respectively. CWSNC also states that it commits to make refunds, including interest at a rate specified by the Commission pursuant to N.C.G.S. § 62-130(e). CWSNC attaches to its Notice, as Appendices A and B, its proposed notices to customers and, as Appendix C, its undertaking to refund.

Based upon the foregoing and the entire record, the Commission concludes that good cause exists to approve the Notices to Customers, attached to this Order as Appendices A and B, and accept CWSNC's undertaking to refund, attached to the Notice as Appendix C.

IT IS, THEREFORE, ORDERED as follows:

- 1. That the Notices to Customers, attached to this Order as Appendices A and B, shall be approved, effective for service rendered on and after January 31, 2023;
- 2. That the Undertaking to Refund, attached to CWSNC's Notice as Appendix C, shall be, and is hereby, accepted;
- 3. That CWSNC shall be, and is hereby, obligated to refund to its customers any amount of temporary rates made effective on and after January 31, 2023, that are finally determined by the Commission to be excessive, plus up to 10% interest per annum, and to make any refunds in a manner consistent with any additional terms and conditions imposed by the Commission in subsequent orders; and
- 4. That CWSNC shall mail or hand deliver to each of its customers copies of the applicable Notices to Customers, attached to this Order as Appendices A and B, within five days from the date of this Order.

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NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that on July 1, 2022, Carolina Water Service, Inc. of North Carolina (CWSNC or the Company) filed an application with the Commission seeking authority to adjust and increase its rates for providing water and sewer utility service in all of its North Carolina service areas and for approval to establish and implement a three-year Water and Sewer Investment Plan (WSIP) pursuant to N.C. Gen. Stat. § 62-133.1B and Commission Rule R1-17A. Pending a final decision on the Company's request for a permanent rate increase, the Company has the legal option to increase its rates and charges, on a temporary basis, subject to refund with interest, pursuant to N.C. Gen. Stat. § 62-135.

On January 13, 2023, CWSNC filed Notice of Intent to Place Temporary Rates in Effect Subject to an Undertaking to Refund Pursuant to N.C. Gen. Stat. § 62-135 (Notice). In summary, the Notice states that CWSNC intends to exercise its statutory right to place into effect temporary rates pending a final order by the Commission approving permanent rates. CWSNC states that its proposed temporary rates will increase its current rates and charges for its CWSNC Uniform Water, CWSNC Uniform Sewer, Bradfield Farms/Fairfield Harbour/Treasure Cove Water, and Bradfield Farms/Fairfield Harbour Sewer Rate Divisions by \$2,166,142, which represents temporary rate increases of 3.501%, 6.323%, 6.978% and 5.653%, respectively. CWSNC also states that it commits to make refunds, including interest at a rate specified by the Commission pursuant to N.C.G.S. § 62-130(e).

The Company's choice on whether to implement temporary rates for water utility service, as allowed pursuant to N.C.G.S. § 62-135, is determined by the Company and is not a decision by the Commission. However, the Commission finds that the Company has satisfied the statutory requirements necessary to place new rates into effect, on a partial, temporary basis and subject to refund with interest at a rate of up to 10% per annum, effective on and after January 31, 2023. In approving this Notice to Customers, the

Commission takes no position on whether the Company should or should not invoke the temporary rates under bond authorized by statute and notes that the decision of whether to implement temporary rates under bond lies solely with the Company.

The temporary rates that the Company is placing into effect on January 31, 2023, pursuant to N.C.G.S. § 62-135 and subject to refund, are as follows:
