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DUKE ENERGY CAROLINAS, LLC AND DUKE ENERGY PROGRESS, LLC'S MOTION FOR EXTENSION OF TIME TO FILE REPLY COMMENTS

NOW COMES Duke Energy Carolinas, LLC ("DEC") and Duke Energy Progress, LLC ("DEP") (collectively, the "Companies"), pursuant to Commission Rule R1-7(a)(5) and the *Order Granting Extension of Time to File Comments and Reply Comments* issued by the North Carolina Utilities Commission ("Commission") in these dockets on September 14, 2022, and respectfully move the Commission for a thirty (30) day extension of time, to and including January 5, 2023, for all parties to file reply comments in the above-captioned dockets. In support of their motion, the Companies show as follows:

- 1. On August 15, 2022, the Companies filed a Joint Petition for Approval of Electric Vehicle Supply Equipment Programs, seeking approval for their proposed Customer Operated Electric Vehicle Supply Equipment ("EVSE") tariff.
- 2. On August 23, 2022, the Commission issued an *Order Requesting Comments on Proposed Customer Operated Electric Vehicle Supply Equipment Tariffs*, setting the date for interventions and initial comments to be filed on or before September 21, 2022, and reply comments to be filed on or before October 5, 2022.

- 3. On September 13, 2022, the Public Staff filed a Motion for Extension of Time, seeking a sixty-day extension of time until November 21, 2022, for the filing of interventions and initial comments and December 5, 2022, for the filing of reply comments.
- 4. On September 14, 2022, the Commission granted the Public Staff's motion by issuance of an *Order Granting Extension of Time to File Comments and Reply comments*.
- 5. On November 21, 2022, initial comments were filed by the Public Staff, ChargePoint, Inc. ("ChargePoint"), EVgo Services, LLC ("EVgo"), and the North Carolina Sustainable Energy Association ("NCSEA").
- 6. The Companies are working diligently to review the initial comments of the four filing parties and believe that an extension of time would assist them in completing their review and drafting their reply comments.
- 7. Based on the foregoing, the Companies respectfully request an extension of thirty days, to and including January 5, 2023, for all parties to file reply comments in these proceedings.
 - 8. The requested extension will not result in prejudice to any party.
- 9. Counsel for the Companies have contacted counsel for all parties of record regarding this requested extension, and no party has advised that it objects.

WHEREFORE, for the reasons set forth above, the Companies respectfully request that the Commission issue an order granting an extension of time to and including January 5, 2023, for all parties to file reply comments in this matter and for such other relief as the Commission deems just and proper.
