BY THE CHAIR: On November 6, 2020, the Commission issued an order in the above-captioned docket that, among other things, allowed all parties, to file, on or before December 1, 2020, initial comments addressing appropriate modifications to the current incentive amounts as directed by this Order, including a tiered rebate program.
