They are asking for a 20% increase in the sewer base rate and a 20% increase in the gallons treated. I wish to remind you the base charge is just to have the meter.

At some point in time, the Commission should realize that we have not received a 23% raise.

I suggest the commission give them exactly what we received in our cost of living increase last year, 2%. That would be 2% in every category. That seems fair.
