BY THE PRESIDING COMMISSIONER: On September 26, 2023, the Natural Resources Defense Council (NRDC) and the Southern Alliance for Clean Energy (SACE) filed a motion in the above-captioned docket, pursuant to Commission Rules R1-7, R1-22 and R1-23, and Rule R1.16 of the North Carolina State Bar Rules of Professional Conduct, requesting that the NRDC be allowed to substitute David L. Neal and Munashe Magarira, both of the Southern Environmental Law Center (SELC), for Gudrun Thompson, also of the SELC, as counsel of record for the NRDC in this proceeding.
