The North Carolina Sustainable Energy Association ("NCSEA") submits this letter to the North Carolina Utilities Commission ("Commission") in support of *Duke Energy Carolinas, LLC's Response to Joint Motion for Reconsideration*.

As noted in *NCSEA's Comments in Support of Revised Application*, the application of Duke Energy Carolinas, LLC ("DEC") for approval of its Residential new Construction Program ("RNCP") has taken several years to reach this point, even though a similar program operated by Duke Energy Progress, LLC has been in place for nearly a decade. NCSEA has reviewed both the *Joint Motion for Reconsideration* and *Duke Energy Carolinas, LLC's Response to Joint Motion for Reconsideration*, and concurs with DEC's analysis and conclusion that there are insufficient grounds to justify the Commission's reconsideration of its determination and order approving DEC's revised RNCP program.
