NOW COME Duke Energy Progress, LLC and Duke Energy Carolinas, LLC (collectively, the "Companies") and the Public Staff of the North Carolina Utilities Commission ("Public Staff"), pursuant to Commission Rule R1-7(a)(5) and the *Order Requiring Information, Requesting Comments and Initiating Rulemaking*, issued by the North Carolina Utilities Commission ("Commission") in this docket on February 4, 2019, and subsequently amended by orders issued April 3, 2019 and June 13, 2019, and respectfully move the Commission for a forty-five day extension of time to September 12, 2019 for all parties to file their comments or proposed rules in the above-captioned docket. In support of their motion, the Companies and the Public Staff show as follows:

1. On February 4, 2019, the Commission issued an order initiating this rulemaking docket regarding Electric Customer Billing Data and directing parties to file comments or proposed rules no later than April 15, 2019.

2. On April 1, 2019, the Public Staff filed a motion requesting an extension of time to June 14, 2019 for parties to file comments or proposed rules. In its motion, the Public Staff advised that it was drafting proposed rules to share with the other parties to

this docket and needed sufficient time for the process. On April 3, 2019, the Commission granted the motion.

3. On June 11, 2019, the Public Staff filed a motion requesting a further extension of time to July 29, 2019, to allow parties sufficient time to review and discuss the draft proposed rules. On June 13, 2019, the Commission granted the motion.

4. The parties have been discussing the draft proposed rules but, due to the press of other business, the Companies and the Public Staff seek additional time to continue those discussions, which may allow consensus to be reached on outstanding issues.


5. The requested extension will not result in prejudice to any party.

6. Counsel for the Public Staff has contacted the parties to this docket about this requested extension, and no party had an objection to it.

7. Counsel for the Public Staff has authorized the undersigned to file this joint motion on the Public Staff's behalf.

WHEREFORE, the Companies and the Public Staff respectfully request that the Commission issue an order extending the time to September 12, 2019 for all parties to file comments or proposed rules, and such other relief as the Commission deems just and proper.


