3. CUCA is an organization of industrial utility customers whose member

companies maintain numerous industrial manufacturing facilities and employ thousands of

workers throughout the State of North Carolina, including the territory in which Progress Energy

Carolinas, Inc. (Progress), Duke Energy Carolinas. LLC ("Duke"), and Dominion North Carolina

Power (NC Power) have been authorized by the Commission to sell electricity at retail.

4. CUCA's member companies use electricity in the operation of their

manufacturing plants. The availability of an adequate supply of electricity at a reasonable price is

critical to the economic viability of CUCA's member companies. As a result, CUCA has a vital

interest in the matters at issue in the above-captioned proceeding and should be permitted to

intervene and participate.
