

RENEWABLE ENERGY PORTFOLIO STANDARD RIDERAPPLICABILITY (North Carolina Only)

Service supplied to the Company's retail customer agreements is subject to a REPS Monthly Charge. This charge is adjusted annually, pursuant to North Carolina General Statute 62-133.8 and North Carolina Utilities Commission Rule R8-67 as ordered by the North Carolina Utilities Commission. This Rider is not applicable to agreements for the Company's outdoor lighting rate schedules, OL, PL, NL, nor for services defined as auxiliary to another agreement. An auxiliary service is defined as a non-demand, nonresidential service, provided on Schedule SGS, at the same premises, with the same service address, and with the same account name as an agreement for which a monthly REPS charge has been applied.

The Commission has ordered that a REPS Monthly Charge, which includes an Experience Modification Factor (EMF), be included in the customers' bills as follows:

To qualify for an auxiliary service, not subject to this Rider, the Customer must notify the Company, and the Company must verify that such agreement is considered an auxiliary service, after which the REPS Billing Factor will not be applied to qualifying auxiliary service agreements. The Customer shall also be responsible for notifying the Company of any change in service that would no longer qualify the service as auxiliary.


