## Deficiencies Regarding Additional Information Filed on February 16, 2016, in Docket Nos. ER-55, Sub 0, and ER-39, Sub 1 Breckenridge Group CNC, LLC (Applicant - Purchaser/Transferee) Aspen Charlotte

Item numbers refer to the corresponding numbers on the application form filed in this docket.

## Item 28.

- (a) As to the Terms of Service that tenants must agree to before being billed by SimpleBills, the "Terms of Service North Carolina" dated 08/01/2016 should be filed in the docket.
- (b) The Applicant should file a statement indicating that it will not charge a credit card chargeback fee.
- (c) In the event a tenant has past due amounts or fails to maintain an active account with SimpleBills throughout the lease term, please explain how the Applicant plans send monthly bills to the tenant. If the Applicant does not send monthly bills for amounts owed, it cannot collect charges from tenants.

## Item 31.

(a) The word "with" should be inserted into the first sentence of the second paragraph of section 6 of the lease agreement as follows: "Each tenant of the Dwelling, including Tenant, is required to enter into an agreement with Utility Servicer (which may change from time to time) for dividing and billing the utilities among the tenants of the Dwelling and which includes a monthly administration processing fee not in excess of \$3.75 per invoice per Tenant."
