BY THE CHAIR: On August 13, 2020, the Commission issued an Order Establishing Biennial Proceeding, Requiring Data, and Scheduling Public Hearing, which in part scheduled for February 16, 2021, a public hearing solely for the purpose of taking nonexpert public witness testimony. On November 24, 2020, the Commission issued an Order Confirming Public Hearing To Be Held Remotely and Requiring Public Notice that provided procedures for the hearing including a requirement for members of the public to register to speak at the hearing prior to 5:00 p.m. on Tuesday, February 9, 2021.

On February 10, 2021, the Public Staff filed a Motion to Cancel Public Hearing. In its motion, the Public Staff requested that the Commission cancel the hearing and noted that no members of the public registered to speak by the registration deadline, and no members of the public submitted comments or statements in the docket. The Public Staff further noted that it contacted the other parties to the proceeding, and no party objected to the cancellation of the public witness hearing.

Based on the foregoing and the record, the Chair finds good cause to cancel the public witness hearing scheduled for February 16, 2021.
