Dear Ms. Dunston:

On behalf of the Village of Bald Head Island, this letter responds to the letter of counsel for Bald Head Island Transportation, Inc. (“BHIT”) and Bald Head Island Limited, LLC (“Limited”) filed October 4, 2022, in the above-referenced proceeding.

- As to the order of the Village’s witnesses, as stated in the Village’s proposed order of witnesses filed on October 3, the Village intends to call witnesses Wright and Gardner in its case-in-chief on their direct testimony and in its rebuttal case on their rebuttal testimony. The Village does intend to call witness O’Donnell in its direct case on both his direct and rebuttal testimony.
- The Village has no objection to the proposed estimated cross times on behalf of BHIT-Limited and SharpVue for witnesses Wright and Gardner on their rebuttal testimony.
- The Village agrees that SharpVue was inadvertently omitted from the “Proposed Order of Cross” column in the attachment to the October 3 filing for witnesses Briggs and Sawyer.
- Finally, the Village notes that its estimated cross times for witnesses Roberts and Paul were inadvertently reversed on the attachment to its October 3 filing. The Village estimates 45 minutes of cross examination for Mr. Roberts and 60 minutes of cross-examination for Mr. Paul.
