Notice is hereby given that HISCO I, LLC (HISCO I), filed with the Commission an Application for the Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity to Provide Sewer Utility Service to Cape Pointe Subdivision, Harkers Island RV Resort, National Park Service Phase 2, National Park Service Shell Point Restroom, Fish Hook Restaurant, LDS Church, The Bridges Youth Ministry, Pasfield Enterprises, Inc., 106 Stacy Drive, 110, 120, 130 and 142 South Ferry Dock Road, and 140 Yeomans Drive in Carteret County, North Carolina.

HISCO I plans to make approximately \$2,940,000 in capital improvements to the wastewater systems over the next five years, including replacing the existing Wastewater Treatment Plant and associated discharge area and equipment. HISCO I also plans, subject to Commission approval, to enhance and expand the existing distribution equipment, broadening the overall service area to accommodate new customers. According to HISCO I, these improvements, as well as others, are necessary to ensure proper operation of the Harkers Island wastewater systems and provide safe and reliable service to current as well as prospective customers.

EFFECT OF RATES:

HISCO I plans to charge Cape Pointe Subdivision, Harkers Island RV Resort (30.76 REUs), National Park Service, Phase 2 (8.19 REUs), National Park Service, Shell Point Restroom (1.67 REUs), Fish Hook Restaurant (5.56 REUs), LDS Church (2.5 REUs), Pasfield Enterprises, Inc. (aka Harkers Island Fishing Center/Motel) (4.67 REUs), The Bridges Youth Ministry (3.74 REUs), 106 Stacy Drive, 110, 120, 130 and 142 South Ferry Dock Road, and 140 Yeomans Drive the following rates:

Monthly Flat Rate Sewer Service: \$60.00 per Residential Equivalent Unit (REU)

Connection Charges: \$3,500 per REU

Reconnection Charge: \$50.00

Returned Check Charge: \$20.00

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Bills Due: on billing date

Bills Past Due: 25 days after billing date

Billing Frequency: Shall be monthly for service in arrears

Finance Charge for Late Payment: 1% per month will be applied to the unpaid balance of all bills still due 25 days after billing date.

1 Residential Equivalent Unit (REU) = 360 gallons per day (GPD)

PROCEDURES FOR PUBLIC HEARINGS:

The Commission has scheduled the following hearings on the Application:

Public witness hearing at 6:00 p.m. on Tuesday, August 20, 2024, to be held in the Carteret County Courthouse, 300 Court House Square, Superior Courtroom 2, Beaufort, North Carolina, 28516. This hearing may be cancelled if no significant protests are received on or before Tuesday, August 13, 2024.

The public witness hearing on Tuesday, August 20, 2024, will be solely for the purpose of receiving the testimony of customers in accordance with Commission Rule R1-21(g). The Commission reserves the right to limit testimony at the public witness hearing pursuant to Commission Rule R1-21(g)(5).

Expert witness hearing at 2:00 p.m. on Monday, October 28, 2024, and continuing as necessary until conclusion. The hearing will be held in Commission Hearing Room 2115, Dobbs Building, 430 North Salisbury Street, Raleigh, North Carolina 27603.

The Public Staff is authorized by statute to represent consumers in proceedings before the Commission. Consumer statements to the Public Staff should include the customer's name, contact information, and any information that the writer wishes to be considered by the Public Staff in its investigation of the matter, and such statements should be addressed to Mr. Christopher J. The direct testimony and exhibits of expert witnesses to be presented by intervenors should also be filed with the Commission on or before Wednesday, September 18, 2024.
