BY THE CHAIR: On July 15, 2019, this matter came on for hearing for the purpose of receiving testimony from the parties' witnesses with respect to certain issues in controversy in this proceeding. Pursuant to the Chair's ruling in open hearing, proposed orders and/or briefs are due to be filed in this docket on or before August 29, 2019.

On August 28, 2019, the Public Staff filed a motion requesting that the Commission grant all parties an additional three days in which to file their proposed orders and/or briefs by establishing September 4, 2019, as the new deadline for these filings. In support of its motion, the Public Staff states that it and the other parties have been diligently working on their proposed orders and/or briefs, but due to the press of other business and the complexity of this proceeding, additional time is needed to complete these filings. In addition, the Public Staff states that it has contacted counsel for the other parties in this proceeding and none expressed objection to the granting of the requested extension of time.


