Dear Ms. Dunston:

Pursuant to the North Carolina Utilities Commission's May 10, 2021 Financing Order, as clarified by the July 13, 2021 Order Clarifying and Correcting Financing Order in Docket No. E-2, Sub 1262 (Financing Order), Duke Energy Progress, LLC (Company) as Servicer of the Senior Secured Series A Storm Recovery Bonds (Storm Recovery Bonds) filed a request for an adjustment to the storm recovery charges on February 22, 2023.

The Company stated that the adjustment is intended to satisfy the requirements of N.C. Gen. Stat. § 62-172(b)(3)d and the Financing Order by ensuring the storm recovery charges will recover amounts sufficient to timely provide for payments of debt service and other required amounts in connection with the Storm Recovery Bonds.

The Public Staff has reviewed the filing for mathematical and clerical errors and is satisfied there are no such errors contained in the filing. The Public Staff also reviewed the ongoing financing costs and servicing fees incurred for the review period and found them reasonable. Based on its review, the Public Staff concluded that the proposed rates are reasonable. Therefore, the Public Staff recommends that the Company's proposed storm cost recovery charges be approved, effective from April 1, 2023.
