BY THE CHAIR: On January 14, 2020, Stanly Solar, LLC (Stanly), filed a Motion for Return of CPRE Proposal Security in the above-captioned dockets (Motion) requesting that the Commission compel Duke Energy Progress, LLC (DEP), to return the \$1 million surety bond provided by Stanly as Proposal Security for its bid in Tranche 1 of the Competitive Procurement of Renewable Energy (CPRE) Program authorized by House Bill 589 (S.L. 2017-192).

On October 20, 2020, the Commission issued its Order Denying Motion for Return of CPRE Proposal Security.

On November 20, 2020, Stanly filed a Petition for Reconsideration.

The Chair finds that good cause exists to issue this Order establishing deadlines for filings responsive to Stanly's Petition for Reconsideration.

## IT IS, THEREFORE, ORDERED as follows:

- 1. DEP and Accion Group, LLC, the Independent Administrator for the CPRE Program, may file Responses to Stanly's Petition for Reconsideration on or before January 5, 2021; and
  - 2. Stanly may file a reply no later than January 26, 2021.
