Dear Ms. Dunston:

On January 4, 2024, the Public Staff filed its Motion to Cancel Public Witness Hearing and informed the Commission that as of Wednesday, January 3, 2024, the deadline to submit significant protests, only one customer of JPC Utilities, LLC (Applicant), had submitted a statement of position, which identified concerns with the rate proposed. The Public Staff also stated that the Applicant and the Public Staff were not aware of any other customer protests or comments made in connection with this matter.

On January 12, 2024, the Public Staff received the attached letter from Clancy Laizure, a commercial customer of the Applicant, and an accompanying petition appearing to have been signed by 35 other individuals. Based on the postmark, it appears that the letter was received by the Post Office on or before December 22, 2023. While the Public Staff has not verified that each signor is a customer of the Applicant, the Public Staff notes that the Applicant provides water utility service to approximately 68 metered commercial customers and wastewater utility service to approximately 57 metered commercial customers.

The Public Staff contacted Mr. Laizure to confirm receipt of his letter and the petition, and to inform him that the Public Staff would address the proposed rate increase in its investigation. Mr. Laizure requested that an in-person public witness hearing be scheduled. He and others were planning to attend and would like to be heard. The Public Staff also contacted counsel for Applicant, who objects

The undersigned request that the proposed 114% increase in water and wastewater applied for by JPC Utilities be denied.

As a business owners in Oak Ridge NC, we are deeply concerned about the proposed 114% increase in water and wastewater service by JPC Utilities. Docket No. W - 1263, Sub 4 by the NC Utilities commission is not just an inconvenience, but will also threaten our livelihood. Our businesses, the backbone of our community will be severely impacted by this drastic hike.

Our businesses are already grappling with economic challenges to recent events. A sudden doubling of utility costs would not only burden us financially, but could also lead to job losses and reduced services for our community members.

The average water bill for small businesses in Oak Ridge is currently around \$100 per month. If this proposal goes through , that cost could more than double to over \$200 per month - a financial burden many of us cannot bear. In a time when small business are already struggling due to economic uncertainties, this additional expense could force many to close their doors permanently.

We understand that utilities companies need to cover their costs and make necessary infrastructure improvements, however, such a significant increase seems excessive and unjustified without clear evidence of its necessity. According to the US Bureau of Labor Statistics the average annual inflation rate over the last decade has been around 1.8%. A sudden jump of utility rates by more than a hundred percent is far beyond any reasonable cost adjustments tied to inflation or operational costs

We urge the NC Utilities Commission to consider the impact on our community before approving such an extreme rate hike. We believe there must be other ways for JPC Utilities to meet its needs without imposing such a heavy burden on its customers.

Please stand with us-sign this petition urging the NC Utilities Commission to deny JPC Utilities application for a 114% increase in water and wastewater service rates.
