ORDER APPROVING PUBLIC NOTICE OF TEMPORARY RATES SUBJECT TO AN UNDERTAKING TO REFUND

BY THE COMMISSION: On June 30, 2022, Aqua North Carolina, Inc. (Aqua or the Company) filed an application with the Commission seeking authority to adjust and increase its rates for providing water and sewer utility service in all of its North Carolina service areas and for approval to establish and implement a three-year Water and Sewer Investment Plan pursuant to N.C. Gen. Stat. § 62-133.1B and Commission Rule R1-17A. On July 26, 2022, the Commission issued an Order Establishing General Rate Case and Suspending Rates, which declared this proceeding to be a general rate case and suspended the proposed rates for up to 270 days pursuant to N.C.G.S. § 62-134.

On September 8, 2022, the Commission issued an Order Scheduling Hearings, Establishing Discovery Guidelines, and Requiring Customer Notice which, among other things, set this matter for expert witness hearing to begin Monday, January 9, 2023, and acknowledged Aqua's intent to implement temporary rates on an interim basis, under bond and subject to refund, for water and sewer utility service rendered on and after January 30, 2023.

The hearing was held as scheduled. Briefs and proposed orders are due on or before February 20, 2023.

On January 26, 2023, Aqua filed Notice of Intent to Place Temporary Rates in Effect Subject to an Undertaking to Refund Pursuant to N.C. Gen. Stat. § 62-135 and Request for Approval of Notice and Undertaking (Notice). In summary, the Notice states that Aqua intends to exercise its statutory right to place into effect temporary rates pending a final order by the Commission approving permanent rates. Aqua states that its proposed temporary rates would be effective for service rendered on and after February 13, 2023. Aqua further states that its temporary rates will be implemented subject to an Undertaking to Refund and that by these rates, the Company will increase its current rates and charges for its Aqua Water Rate Division by \$4,208,356, Aqua Sewer Rate Division by \$1,767,004, Brookwood Water Rate Division by \$723,966, Fairways Water Rate Division by \$144,239,

and Fairways Sewer Rate Division by \$254,832, which represent temporary rate increases of 9.9%, 9.5%, 11.1%, 10.9%, and 11.3%, respectively. Aqua also states that it commits to make refunds, including interest, at a rate specified by the Commission pursuant to N.C.G.S. § 62-130(e). Aqua attaches to its Notice, as Appendices A-1, A-2, B, and C, its proposed notices to customers and, as Appendix D, its undertaking to refund.

On February 2, 2023, the Public Staff filed a letter indicating that it believes the temporary rates set out in Aqua's Notice comply with the requirement of N.C.G.S. § 62-135(b) that temporary rates shall not result in an increase of more than 20% on any single rate classification of the public utility. However, the Public Staff asserts that the temporary rates fail to meet the requirement of N.C.G.S. § 62-130(a) that rates allowed by the Commission be just and reasonable or the requirement of N.C.G.S. § 62-140 that public utilities not establish any unreasonable difference as to rates or services as between localities or classes of service. The Public Staff asserts that there is an increased likelihood that Aqua's proposed temporary rates will result in the need for a refund to customers based on the revenue requirements recommended by the Public Staff and the estimated revenues produced by the Company's proposed rates.

Also on February 2, 2023, Aqua filed a Clarification of Notice of Intent to Place Temporary Rates into Effect. Aqua states that Aqua's rate classifications are the five rate divisions listed in paragraph eight of its Notice. Aqua states that its Notice complies with the statutory limit set out in N.C.G.S. § 62-135 because the revenue increase under temporary rates will be less than 20% for each of Aqua's rate classifications. Aqua further clarifies that the temporary rate for customers within the Aqua Sewer Rate Division who have metered usage will include a volumetric (or usage) component that is greater than 20%. However, Aqua states that the revenue increase for that Rate Division will not be greater than 20% under temporary rates.

In addition, on February 3, 2023, Aqua filed a reply to the Public Staff's letter regarding temporary rates. On that same date, the Public Staff filed an additional letter regarding temporary rates.

Based upon the foregoing and the entire record, the Commission concludes that good cause exists to approve the Notices to Customers, attached to this Order as Appendices A-1, A-2, B, and C, and accept Aqua's undertaking to refund, attached to the Notice as Appendix D.

IT IS, THEREFORE, ORDERED as follows:

1. That the Notices to Customers, attached to this Order as Appendices A-1, A-2, B, and C, shall be approved, effective for service rendered on and after February 13, 2023;

2. That the Undertaking to Refund, attached to Aqua's Notice as Appendix D, shall be, and is hereby, accepted;

3. That Aqua shall be, and is hereby obligated, to refund to its customers any amount of temporary rates made effective on and after February 13, 2023, that are finally determined by the Commission to be excessive, plus up to 10% interest per annum, and to make any refunds in a manner consistent with any additional terms and conditions imposed by the Commission in subsequent orders; and

4. That Aqua shall mail or hand deliver to each of its customers copies of the applicable Notices to Customers, attached to this Order as Appendices A-1, A-2, B, and C, within three days from the date of this Order.

Aqua's choice to implement temporary rates under bond effective for water and sewer utility service rendered on and after February 13, 2023, as allowed pursuant to N.C.G.S. § 62-135, is determined by the Company and is not a decision by the Commission. However, the Commission finds that Aqua has satisfied the statutory requirements necessary to place new rates into effect on a partial, temporary basis and subject to refund with interest at a rate of up to 10% per annum, effective on February 13, 2023. In approving this Notice to Customers, the Commission takes no position on whether Aqua should or should not invoke the temporary rates under bond authorized by statute and notes that the decision of whether to implement temporary rates under bond lies solely with the Company.

#### **TEMPORARY RATES SUBJECT TO UNDERTAKING TO REFUND**

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN THAT on June 30, 2022, Aqua North Carolina, Inc. (Aqua or Company) filed an application with the Commission seeking authority to adjust and increase its rates for providing water and sewer utility service in all of its North Carolina service areas and for approval to establish and implement a three-year Water and Sewer Investment Plan pursuant to N.C. Gen. Stat. § 62-133.1B and Commission Rule R1-17A. Aqua has the legal option to increase its rates and charges, on a temporary basis, subject to refund, pursuant to N.C.G.S. § 62-135. These rate changes are not final rates and remain subject to the Commission's final determination of the just and reasonable rates to be charged by Aqua on a permanent basis pursuant to Aqua's pending rate case application.

On January 26, 2023, Aqua filed Notice of Intent to Place Temporary Rates in Effect Subject to an Undertaking to Refund Pursuant to N.C. Gen. Stat. § 62-135 and Request for Approval of Notice and Undertaking (Notice). In summary, the Notice states that Aqua intends to exercise its statutory right to place into effect temporary rates pending a final order by the Commission approving permanent rates. Aqua states that its proposed temporary rates would be effective for service rendered on and after February 13, 2023. Aqua further states that its temporary rates will be implemented subject to an Undertaking to Refund and that by these rates, the Company will increase its current rates and charges for its Aqua Water Rate Division by \$4,208,356, Aqua Sewer Rate Division by \$1,767,004, Brookwood Water Rate Division by \$254,832, which represent temporary rate increases of 9.9%, 9.5%, 11.1%, 10.9%, and 11.3%, respectively. Aqua also states that it commits to make refunds, including interest, at a rate specified by the Commission pursuant to N.C.G.S. § 62-130(e).
