BY THE CHAIR: On April 15, 2020, in the above-captioned docket the Commission issued its Order Establishing Standard Rates and Contract Terms for Qualifying Facilities in its 2018 biennial avoided cost proceeding pursuant to the provisions of Section 210 of the Public Utility Regulatory Policies Act of 1978 (PURPA) and N.C. Gen. Stat. § 62-156.

On May 8, 2020, the North Carolina Sustainable Energy Association and the North Carolina Clean Energy Business Alliance (Movants), each parties to this proceeding, filed a Joint Motion for an Extension of Time to File Notice of Appeal and Exceptions pursuant to N.C.G.S. § 62-90(a) seeking an additional 30 days within which to appeal the Commission's April 15, 2020 Order. Movants explain that they have diligently worked through the lengthy Order but anticipate needing additional time to adequately assess whether to file a Notice of Appeal and Exceptions. Movants further represent that they contacted counsel for all other parties, a number responded, and no party objected to the motion.


The Chair finds good cause to grant the requested extension of time.
