BY THE CHAIR: On March 18, 2021, the Commission issued an Order scheduling the above-captioned docket for hearing and establishing procedural deadlines which in part scheduled a hearing for the purpose of receiving expert witness testimony at 1:00 p.m. on Tuesday, June 1, 2021. Pursuant to that Order, parties participating in the expert witness hearing are required to file a list of potential cross-examination and redirect exhibits and provide copies of the exhibits to the other parties and to the Commission on or before May 21, 2021.

On May 7, 2021, Sierra Club filed a motion requesting an extension of time to file direct testimony and exhibits on May 17, 2021, and to allow Duke Energy Carolinas, LLC (DEC) to file its rebuttal testimony on or before May 27, 2021. The Commission issued an order granting that motion on May 11, 2021.

On May 20, 2021, the Sierra Club filed a motion requesting an extension to file potential cross-examination and redirect exhibits. In order to allow parties to identify potential exhibits after the time for the filing of DEC's rebuttal testimony, the Sierra Club requested that all parties be allowed to provide the potential cross-examination and redirect exhibits on May 28, 2021. The Sierra Club stated that it contacted counsel for the parties to the docket and that no party objected to the extension of time.

Based on Sierra Club's motion and the record herein, the Chair finds good cause to grant Sierra Club and all other intervenors an extension of time to and including May 28, 2021, to file direct testimony in this docket. Further, the Chair finds good cause to allow DEC to file its rebuttal testimony on or before May 27, 2021.

IT IS, THEREFORE, ORDERED as follows:

1. That the parties participating in the expert witness portion of the remote hearing shall file a list of potential cross-examination exhibits and provide copies of the exhibits, labeled with the party's name and numbered sequentially, to the other parties

and to the Commission via email at ncucexhibits@ncuc.net on or before Friday, May 21, 2021; and

2. That the parties participating in the expert witness portion of the remote hearing shall file a list of potential redirect examination exhibits and provide copies of the exhibits, labeled with the party's name and numbered sequentially, to the other parties and to the Commission via email at ncucexhibits@ncuc.net on or before Friday, May 21, 2021.
