BY THE PRESIDING COMMISSIONER: On July 12, 2021, Juno Solar, LLC (Juno) filed an application for a conditional certificate of public convenience and necessity (CPCN) to construct a solar energy facility with a capacity of up to 275 MW<sub>AC</sub> (Facility) to be located in Richmond County, North Carolina (EMP-116, Sub 0).

On March 29, 2022, Juno filed a notice of withdrawal of its application for a conditional certificate of public convenience and necessity to construct the Facility.

Considering the foregoing and the record in this proceeding, the Presiding Commissioner acknowledges Juno's withdrawal of its application and finds good cause to close the docket.
