

PUBLIC NOTICE DOCKET NO. SP-6476, SUB 0 APPLICATION OF ALBEMARLE BEACH SOLAR, LLC FOR A CERTIFICATE OF PUBLIC CON- VENIENCE AND NE- CESSITY

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that on September 21, 2015, Albemarle Beach Solar, LLC (Applicant), filed an application seeking a certificate of public convenience and necessity pursuant to G.S. 62-110.1(a) for construction of an 80-MW solar generating facility to be located on both sides of Mackeys Road and Albemarle Beach Road in Roper, Washington County, North Carolina. The Applicant is in discussions to sell the output through a negotiated Power Purchase Agreement to Dominion North Carolina Power, or to one or more retail customers in deregulated states that allow for such sales, or to sell the output in the PJM market.
