ORDER GRANTING NCSEA'S MOTION
FOR WITHDRAWAL WITHOUT PREJUDICE

BY THE COMMISSION: On July 29, 2022, the North Carolina Sustainable Energy Association (NCSEA) filed a motion requesting to withdraw from participation as a party in the above-captioned dockets without prejudice, pursuant to Commission Rules R1-1 and R1-7 (July 2022 Motion). In support of the motion, NCSEA stated that the above-captioned proceedings have not seen substantive filings in an extended period of time but nonetheless remain open in the Commission docket system. NCSEA further noted that due to staffing changes NCSEA would soon no longer employ an in-house attorney who had worked on these proceedings. Accordingly, NCSEA requested to withdraw as a party to the above-captioned proceedings without prejudice so that, in the event that these dockets become active again, it may repetition to intervene.

On June 26, 2023, NCSEA filed a motion requesting that in the event the Commission denies the July 2022 Motion, the Commission instead allow the withdrawal of Taylor M. Jones as counsel in each of the above-captioned dockets and substitution of Ethan C. Blumenthal as counsel for NCSEA.

Based on the foregoing and the entire record herein, the Commission finds that there is justifiable cause to grant NCSEA's motion to withdraw without prejudice.

IT IS, THEREFORE, ORDERED that NCSEA is allowed to withdraw from participation as a party in the above-captioned dockets without prejudice.
