NCEMC purchases power and energy pursuant to wholesale contracts with Duke Energy Progress, LLC (“DEP”) to supply its members. These members, in turn, supply power to their members, the end-use retail consumers.
2. NCEMC is also a DEP retail customer.
3. No other party can adequately represent NCEMC’s interests in this proceeding.
4. NCEMC agrees to accept electronic service of all filings in the Docket.
5. NCEMC asks that the Commission make it a party to this proceeding and to exercise all rights provided to intervenors under North Carolina law and this Commission’s rules.


