NOW COMES Duke Energy Carolinas, LLC (the "Company"), by and through counsel and pursuant to Rules R1-7 and R1-9 of the Rules and Regulations of the North Carolina Utilities Commission ("Commission"), and respectfully requests that the Commission enter an order granting a one-week extension of time until July 27, 2017 for the Company to answer or satisfy the complaint of Fresh Air II, LLC ("Complainant") at issue in this proceeding.

The Company shows the Commission the following:

- 1. On June 15, 2017, Complainant filed its Complaint ("Complaint") with the Commission.
- 2. On June 20, 2017, the Commission issued an *Order Serving Complaint* and Requiring Response, directing the Company to either satisfy the demands of the Complainant and so advise the Commission, or file a response to the Complaint on or before July 20, 2017.

- 3. Complainant's Complaint is complex in nature and requires significant time to review and analyze. The Company has worked diligently toward preparing its answer; however, the press of other business has delayed completion of the filing.
- 4. The additional time will also allow counsel for the Company to engage in discussions with counsel for the Complainant on the matters set forth in the Complaint.
- 5. Counsel for Complainant has authorized the Company to state that Complainant does not oppose the requested extension.

WHEREFORE, the Companies respectfully request that the Commission grant an extension until July 27, 2017 to answer or satisfy the Complaint at issue in this proceeding and any such further relief as the Commission deems just and proper.
