NOW COMES Currituck Water and Sewer LLC (“CWS”) and moves for a continuance of the hearing presently scheduled to begin on Monday, May 9, 2022. The parties to these dockets are currently engaged in discussions in an effort to resolve some or all of the contested outstanding issues. While progress along these lines has been made, it will not be possible to conclude the discussions by May 9, 2022. A number of parties and participants are involved, the issues do not lend themselves to easy solutions, the facts upon which settlement discussions depend continue to evolve, and when and if the negotiating participants reach tentative agreement, additional approvals and authorizations will be necessary.

With respect to rescheduling, the parties request that they be allowed three weeks to reach agreement, and should there be no agreement within that timeframe, any party may file a motion that the Commission reschedule the hearing.

CWS has informed the other parties to these dockets of its intent to file this motion, and they have authorized CWS to state that they concur.

WHEREFORE Currituck Water and Sewer Company respectfully requests a continuance of the hearing presently scheduled for May 9, 2022.
