BY THE PRESIDING COMMISSIONER: On December 3, 2020, in response to a motion by Duke Energy Carolinas, LLC (DEC), the Public Staff, and Public Service Company of North Carolina, Inc. (collectively Movants), the Commission issued an Order Granting Third Extension of Time to File Comments in the above-captioned docket. The Order extended to December 18, 2020, the date for the Public Staff, intervenors, and the local distribution natural gas companies (LDCs), to file comments on DEC's revised Residential New Construction (RNC) Program.

On December 16, 2020, Movants filed a joint motion requesting that the Commission grant a further extension of time to January 19, 2021. In summary, Movants stated that they have continued to meet to discuss DEC's revised RNC Program, and that DEC has been modeling various scenarios that have been and will be reviewed by Movants. Further, Movants stated that the discussions appear to have the potential to produce positive results but require additional time. Finally, Movants stated that they were authorized to represent that the Southern Environmental Law Center and the North Carolina Sustainable Energy Association do not oppose Movants' request for a further extension of time.

Based on Movants' motion and the record, the Presiding Commissioner finds good cause to extend to January 19, 2021, the date for the Public Staff, intervenors, and the LDCs to file comments.

IT IS, THEREFORE, SO ORDERED.
