BY THE CHAIRMAN: On January 23, 2019, the Commission issued an Order Modifying Program (Rider MROP Order) in the above-captioned docket that approved guidelines that allow customers of Duke Energy Progress, LLC (DEP) to opt out of having an Advanced Metering Infrastructure (AMI or smart) meter installed at their premises. In addition, the Rider MROP Order required DEP to file a proposed Rider MROP tariff and implementation plan by February 1, 2019.

On February 1, 2019, DEP filed its proposed Rider MROP tariff and implementation plan.

On May 1, 2019, the Public Staff filed a letter stating that it has reviewed DEP's proposed Rider MROP tariff and implementation plan and concluded that they comply with the Commission's Rider MROP Order. As a result, the Public Staff recommended that the Commission approve DEP's tariff and implementation plan.

In addition, the Commission received several consumer statements of position about DEP's proposed Rider MROP tariff and implementation plan.

Based on the foregoing and the record, the Chairman finds good cause to approve DEP's Rider MROP tariff and implementation plan.

IT IS, THEREFORE, SO ORDERED.
