NOW COMES THE PUBLIC STAFF – North Carolina Utilities Commission, by and through its Executive Director, Christopher J. Ayers, and respectfully requests that the Commission extend the time for filing initial comments in the above-captioned dockets, up to and including April 25, 2023; and that the Commission extend the time for filing reply comments in the above-captioned dockets, up to and including May 16, 2023. In support of this motion, the Public Staff shows as follows:

- 1. On January 27, 2023, Duke Energy Carolinas, LLC, and Duke Energy Progress, LLC (together, Duke Energy or the Companies) filed a joint petition seeking approval of the Green Source Advantage Choice Program.
- 2. On February 9, 2023, the Commission issued an Order Requesting Comments, requiring that initial comments be filed by March 28, 2023, and that reply comments be filed by April 11, 2023.

- 3. As of the date of this filing, the Attorney General's Office, the North Carolina Sustainable Energy Association, the Carolina Industrial Group for Fair Utility Rates II and III, the Carolina Utility Customers Association, the Southern Alliance for Clean Energy, the Clean Energy Buyers Association, and Google LLC have intervened in the above-captioned dockets.
- 4. The Public Staff has been working diligently to review the joint petition. Because of the press of ongoing dockets and deadlines, the Public Staff requires additional time to review the Companies' discovery responses and conduct a thorough assessment of the proposed program. As such, the Public Staff requests an additional 28 days for parties to file initial comments in these dockets, up to and including April 25, 2023; and that parties have 21 days to file reply comments, up to and including May 16, 2023.
- 5. The Public Staff has conferred with Duke Energy and all other parties in the above-captioned dockets and is authorized to represent that there are no objections to this motion.

THEREFORE, the Public Staff respectfully requests that the Commission issue an order extending the deadline for the filing of initial comments to April 25, 2023, and extending the deadline for the filing of reply comments to May 16, 2023.
