BY THE CHAIR: On August 6, 2019, the Commission issued an Order Granting Motion for Extension of Time to File Reply Comments in response to a motion by the Public Staff filed in the above-captioned dockets. The Order granted all parties an extension to September 6, 2019, to file reply comments regarding the demand-side management and energy efficiency (DSM/EE) mechanisms by which Duke Energy Progress, LLC, and Duke Energy Carolinas, LLC (collectively, Duke) recover their DSM/EE costs and incentives.

On August 30, 2019, the Public Staff filed a motion requesting that the date for reply comments be further extended to October 7, 2019. The Public Staff stated that a meeting of the parties who filed initial comments on Duke's DSM/EE mechanisms was held on August 15, 2019, and a second meeting is scheduled for September 6, 2019. In addition, the Public Staff stated that the requested extension of time will allow the parties to work toward a potential resolution of some or all of the issues. Further, the Public Staff stated that it contacted all the parties who filed initial comments about its proposed extension of time to file reply comments, and that they all indicated their assent to the proposed extension of time.

Based on the Public Staff's motion and the record, the Chair finds good cause to extend to October 7, 2019, the date for parties to file reply comments on Duke's DSM/EE mechanisms.

IT IS, THEREFORE, SO ORDERED.
