ORDER GRANTING EXTENSION OF TIME

BY THE PRESIDING COMMISSIONER: On September 2, 2011, the Public Staff filed a motion in the above-captioned docket requesting the Commission to enter an order extending the time for filing of the direct testimony and exhibits by the Public Staff and other intervenors from Wednesday, September 7, 2011, to Friday, September 9, 2011, and rebuttal testimony and exhibits from Friday, September 16, 2011, to Tuesday, September 20, 2011.
