On March 28, 2024, Old North State Water Company, Inc. (Applicant), filed an application in Docket No. W-1300, Sub 83, seeking a certificate of public convenience and necessity to provide water utility service in Phase 4 of The Reserve at Falls Lake subdivision in Wake County, North Carolina.

The Public Staff has reviewed the application and identified the material deficiency listed below.

1. A copy of the letter from the Department of Environmental Quality granting approval of plans for the water system was not provided.

Based on the foregoing, the Public Staff respectfully recommends that the Commission determine that the item enumerated above is a deficiency and renders the application incomplete. If the Commission does not consider the item enumerated a deficiency, the Public Staff respectfully requests that the Commission issue an order
