BY THE CHAIR: On February 4, 2019, the Commission issued an Order in the above-captioned docket initiating a rulemaking on access to electric customer usage data. On September 12, 2019, the Commission issued an Order Granting Motion for Further Extension of Time. The Order extended the date for parties to file initial comments and/or proposed rules to November 12, 2019.

On November 7, 2019, Duke Energy Carolinas, LLC, and Duke Energy Progress, LLC (collectively, Duke), filed a motion requesting an additional extension of time to February 10, 2020, for parties to file initial comments and/or proposed rules. In summary, Duke stated that the parties have been discussing separate proposals for draft rules, but that they need additional time to continue their discussions. Further, Duke stated that the additional time may allow for consensus to be reached on the outstanding issues. In addition, Duke stated that it contacted all parties to this proceeding about the requested extension of time, and no party voiced an objection.

Based on Duke's motion and the record, the Chair finds good cause to extend the date for all parties to file initial comments and/or proposed rules to February 10, 2020.
