NOW COMES MRT-1, LLC, by and through counsel, and respectfully, and respectfully moves that the Commission to enter an order allowing for the Substitution of MRT-1, LLC as the Complainant in the above-captioned matter. In support of this motion and in compliance with Rule R1-7 of the NCUC Rules, the undersigned shows the Commission, as follows:

- 1. Complainant initially filed its Complaint on May 2, 2019.
- 2. On May 10, 2019, the Commission issued its "Order Serving Complaint" directing Respondent HISCO to file an answer or other response on or before May 24, 2019.
- 3. On May 24, 2019, counsel for Respondent requested an extension of time through and including June 4, 2019. Complainant's counsel did not oppose the request for an extension of time, contingent upon it being for no longer than approximately 10 days.
- 4. By order entered May 30, 2019, the Commission granted the requested extension through and including June 4, 2019.

- 5. On June 3, 2019, counsel for Respondent requested a second extension of time through and including June 14, 2019.
- 6. On June 5, 2019, the Commission granted the requested extension through and including June 14, 2019.
- 7. On June 18, 2019, the Commission entered the Order Serving Corrected Answers and Responses, and directed Complainant to respond on or before July 1.
 - 8. Complainant initially filed its Complaint on May 2, 2019.
- 9. Following receipt of Respondent's Answer, on June 27, 2019, Complainant filed its first motion for extension of time to reply to the Answer of Respondent, which was allowed by the Commission.
- 10. On July 31, 2019, Complainant filed its second motion for extension of time to reply to the Answer of Respondent, which was allowed by the Commission.
- 11. On August 19, 2019, Complainant filed its third first motion for extension of time to reply to the Answer of Respondent, which was allowed by the Commission.
- 12. On September 19, 2019, Complainant filed its fourth motion for extension of time to reply to the Answer of Respondent, which was allowed by the Commission.
- 13. On October 21, 2019, Complainant filed its Response to the Answer of Respondent, said response outlining that the Respondent's Answer was not satisfactory, but also requesting the Commission keep the docket open for at least six months so that the matters complained of could be monitored by the Complainant and the Commission.
- 14. Thereafter, all of the real property at issue in the above-captioned matter was conveyed by Complainant or its affiliate to MRT-1, LLC via deed recorded December 30, 2019 in Book 1659, at Page 65 of the Carteret County Registry.

15. In connection with the aforementioned conveyance, the claims raised in the above-

captioned matter were assigned to MRT-1, LLC by Complainant or its affiliate.

16. MRT-1, LLC is the present record title owner of all of the real property at issue in

the above-captioned Complaint, and is the holder and owner of all claims set forth in the above-

captioned Complaint.

17. MRT-1, LLC is the validly existing successor in interest to the named Complainant,

or its affiliates, as a result of the contents of the immediately preceding paragraph.

18. Rule R1-7(a)(3) expressly contemplates the substitution of parties in matters filed

before the Commission.

19. MRT-1, LLC hereby submits to the Commission a request that it be substituted in as

the Party Complainant as the present record title owner of the real property at issue in the Complaint

submitted in this matter, and that the presently named Complainant be substituted out as no longer

having any interest in the real property and the matters raised in said Complaint.

20. Counsel for MRT-1, LLC has reached out to counsel for Respondent for the purposes

of requesting consent to the filing of this Motion, but has not received a substantive response.

WHEREFORE, the undersigned counsel for Complainant and MRT-1, LLC respectfully

requests that the Commission issue an Order Granting MRT-1, LLC's motion to be substituted in as

the Party Complainant in the above-captioned matter, and that the presently identified Complainant,

Pinnacle Bank, be removed as a party to this action.
