Docket No. SP-5252, Sub 0, involves an amendment to the application for a certificate of public convenience and necessity (CPCN) pursuant to G.S. 62-110.1 for construction of a 5-MW solar photovoltaic electric generating facility to be located in Mount Olive, Wayne County, North Carolina. A CPCN was granted on May 12, 2015. The Applicant filed an amendment on September 21, 2017, to revise the location description of the original site plan and to reduce the maximum size of the facility to 3.4 MW.

Appropriate publication, service, and review of the amendment has taken place, as shown in the Commission's docket system. The Public Staff has reviewed the amendment and determined that it complies with the requirements of G.S. 62-110.1 and Commission Rule R8-64.

The Public Staff does not believe this matter requires presentation at a Staff Conference, but instead may be approved by the Commission based upon this letter and the filings. This is one of two agenda items that the Public Staff would present on February 26, 2018, so the Staff Conference on that day may be cancelled if the Commission approves both of these matters outside of Staff
