NOW COMES Public Service Company of North Carolina, Incorporated d/b/a Dominion Energy North Carolina (PSNC), Duke Energy Carolinas, LLC (DEC), and the Public Staff – North Carolina Utilities Commission (Joint Movants), and respectfully move that the Commission extend the time to file comments in this docket to December 18, 2020.

In support thereof, the Joint Movants show the Commission as follows:

- 1. On September 21, 2020, DEC filed a revised proposed Residential New Construction Program (Program) pursuant to the Commission's June 23, 2020 Order in this docket (Order), Commission Rule R8-68, and the Commission's Orders, dated February 29, 2008, and March 13, 2008, in Docket No. E-100, Sub 113, Rulemaking Proceeding to Implement Session Law 2007-397.
- 2. Pursuant to the Order and Rule R8-68(d)(2), intervenors and the natural gas utilities were allowed to file comments on the proposed Program within 30 days of the filing of the Program.
- 3. On October 15, 202, the Public Staff requested a 30-day extension of the time by which intervenors may file comments to November 20, 2020. The Commission granted this request on October 20, 2020.
 - 4. On November 4, 2020, DEC, Piedmont Natural Gas, Inc. (Piedmont), ¹

¹ Piedmont has not yet intervened in this docket, but it plans to do so and to file comments.

PSNC, and the Public Staff met to discuss various issues surrounding the Program. Based on these discussions, on November 16, 2020, the Joint Movants sought an extension of two weeks to December 4, 2020, to file comments on the Program. The Commission granted this request on November 17, 2020.

5. The Joint Movants have continued their discussions and have been exchanging information regarding the Program. The Joint Movants request an additional two weeks to conclude their discussions and, therefore, they request a two week extension of the time for filing comments, up to any including Friday, December 18, 2020.

6. The Joint Movants have contacted the other parties to the proceeding and are authorized to represent that the North Carolina Sustainable Energy Association does not oppose the request.

WHEREFORE, the Joint Movants respectfully request that the Commission extend the time for all parties to file comments regarding the Program to December 18, 2020.
