BY THE CHAIRMAN: On May 24, 2013, the Commission issued an Order Granting Further Extensions of Time in the above-captioned docket rescheduling the dates for the filing of petitions to intervene and direct testimony and exhibits of the Public Staff and intervenors to May 31, 2013, and for the filing of rebuttal testimony by Duke Energy Carolinas, LLC (Duke), to June 3, 2013.

On Friday, May 31, 2013, the Public Staff made a verbal request that the date for the filing of petitions to intervene and intervenor testimony be extended to Monday, June 3, 2013. In support of its motion, the Public Staff stated that it has reached an agreement in principle with Duke settling the issues in this proceeding and needs additional time to prepare the stipulation and accompanying testimony or affidavits. In addition, the Public Staff stated that Duke does not intend to file rebuttal testimony, and the other parties to this docket have no objection to the Public Staff's motion for additional time.


Based on the Public Staff's motion and the record in this docket, the Chairman is of the opinion that good cause exists to grant the requested additional extension of time.

IT IS, THEREFORE, ORDERED that the time for filing petitions to intervene and the testimony and exhibits of expert witnesses of the Public Staff and intervenors is extended to Monday, June 3, 2013.
