BY THE PRESIDING COMMISSIONER: On May 24, 2019, in the above-captioned docket, the Commission issued an Order Granting Motion for an Extension of Time to File Response whereby the Commission granted the Public Staff – North Carolina Utilities Commission’s (Public Staff’s) motion filed on that same date for an extension of time until Friday, June 7, 2019, to file its response in compliance with the Commission’s May 17, 2019 Order Clarifying Rate Base Reduction Concerning CIAC and Requesting Response.

On June 6, 2019, the Public Staff filed a Motion for a Second Extension of Time to File Response wherein the Public Staff stated that since the Commission granted the Public Staff’s first motion for extension on May 24, 2019, a staff member integral to the completion of the Public Staff’s response to the May 17, 2019 Order has been out of the office due to both exigent circumstances and a planned absence. The Public Staff maintained that for this reason it needs an additional two weeks to complete its response in compliance with the May 17, 2019 Order. The Public Staff requested a further extension of time, to and including Friday, June 21, 2019, to file its response in this docket. The Public Staff stated that the other parties to this proceeding do not object to the Public Staff’s Motion.

Based upon the foregoing and the record, the Presiding Commissioner finds good cause to grant the Public Staff’s Motion. Therefore, the Public Staff is hereby granted an extension of time to and including Friday, June 21, 2019, to file its response to the Commission’s May 17, 2019 Order Clarifying Rate Base Reduction Concerning CIAC and Requesting Response.

IT IS, THEREFORE, SO ORDERED.
