On December 21 and 22, 2009 Duke Energy Carolinas, LLC (Duke) filed revised rate schedules, riders, and regulations in Docket No. E-7, Sub 909 to correct typographical errors and make other changes requested by the Public Staff and other parties. On December 21. 2009 Duke also filed new Rider EE pursuant to the Commission's Notice of Decision in Docket No. E-7, Sub 831, the REPS Rider pursuant to the Commission's Order in Docket No. E-7, Sub 872, and a Notice to Customers in Docket Nos. E-7, Sub 909, 831, and 872.

The Public Staff has reviewed the revised rate schedules, riders, and regulations, new Rider EE, the REPS Rider, and the Notice to Customers. It appears that the list of counties in Schedule GL was not corrected as described in paragraph 10 of the Public Staff's Comments of December 21, 2009; however, it is our understanding Duke intends to file a corrected tariff.
