BY THE CHAIR: On March 9, 2021, the Commission issued an Order Seeking Comments Regarding Generator Inspection Provisions of The North Carolina Generator Interconnection Standards. On March 1, 2021, Duke Energy Carolinas, LLC, and Duke Energy Progress, LLC (jointly, Duke), filed a report on its Interconnection Fee-Related Work and Post-Commercial Operation Inspections for 2020, (2020 Inspection Report) which provides the Commission with an update on the status of Duke’s work on an inspection program. In its 2020 Inspection Report Duke noted that stakeholders have raised concerns and questions regarding the inspections. The Commission provided that parties to this docket may file comments on these issues by March 19, 2021, and reply comments on or before March 31, 2021.

On March 15, 2021, Carolinas Clean Energy Business Association (CCEBA) filed a letter in the docket noting that it was the successor in interest to the North Carolina Clean Energy Business Alliance (NCCEBA). On that same day, CCEBA filed a motion requesting an extension of time to file comments on the 2020 Inspection Report. In support of its motion, CCEBA stated that the press of other business before the Commission and the South Carolina Public Service Commission would make it difficult for parties to provide comments on these issues. CCEBA requested that parties be allowed to file comments on these issues by March 29, 2021, and reply comments on or before April 12, 2021. CCEBA also stated that Duke, the Public Staff, the North Carolina Sustainable Energy Association, and the Interstate Renewable Energy Council have indicated they do not oppose the motion.

Based on the motion, the Chair finds good cause to grant the extension for comments from the parties.

IT IS, THEREFORE, ORDERED as follows:

1. That parties may file comments on these issues by March 29, 2021; and

2. That parties may file reply comments on or before April 12, 2021.
