

of those proposed changes), adjust its filed case for June 30 updates, pursue settlement, and prepare rebuttal testimony.

In order to allow the parties to continue the pursuit of a possible settlement of this docket, and for all of the other reasons set forth above, Piedmont requests additional time to file rebuttal testimony in this proceeding. Accordingly, Piedmont respectfully seeks a seven (7) day extension of time in which it may file rebuttal testimony.

Piedmont represents it is authorized to state that the Public Staff consents, and CIGFUR IV, the Attorney General, Fayetteville Public Works Commission and Nucor do not object to the requested extension of time to file rebuttal testimony set forth herein. Piedmont has attempted to get a response from CUCA but as of the filing of the Motion has not heard back from counsel.


