NOW COME the below listed customers of Respondent, Outer Banks/Kinnnakeet Associates LLC., and property owners within the Kinnakeet Shores subdivision and seek to intervene in this docket in their own right in support of Kinnakeet Shores Home Owners Inc. ("Complainant" or "HOA"), pursuant to NCUC Rule R1-19.

Complainant respectfully requests that the Commission grant the relief sought by Complainant.

Petitioners concur with Complainant that consumers of Respondent are in immediate need of the Commission's assistance in addressing the deficiencies outlined in the Complaint.

The North Carolina Division of Environmental Quality has placed the Kinnakeet Shores waste water system of Respondent on moratorium. The wastewater treatment plant major treatment

units are no longer functional. Both clarifiers, the tertiary filter, spray irrigation system, and backup generator are no longer functional. Biosolids have not been removed from the plant for at least seven years. DEQ has placed WWTP on sewer moratorium with no new sewer taps, sewer extensions or additional flow effective as of the date of the moratorium.

Property owners within Kinnakeet Shores who have not constructed homes on their lots are prevented from doing so. The moratorium has a detrimental effect on the community.

The undersigned are directly affected by the actions and inactions of Respondent with respect to its provision of service within the community.

Petitioners participation in this docket will bring critical insight, knowledge, and understanding of the preceding. The address of the spokesman for the undersigned consumers is:

Wherefore, for the reasons set forth above, Petitioners pray that they be allowed to intervene in this matter.

## North Carolina Utilities Commission:

Farrell & Family Construction Company currently owns three vacant lots in addition to one near completion home in Phase 16 of Greater Kinnakeet Shores, Avon, NC. Our business was immediately affected by the sewer moratorium that went into effect October 13, 2021. We were unable to build homes for clients who had expressed and interest and had begun to move forward with selling their home and getting plans engineered. The moratorium has impacted not only us as a company, the prospective homeowners, but also the livelihoods of the numerous small subcontractors we hire. Not knowing when sewer service will be up and running has created a tremendous hardship for many-builders, property owners, potential buyers, subcontractors and their employees.
