NOW COMES AQUA NORTH CAROLINA, INC. ("Aqua" or "Company"), by and through the undersigned counsel, to notify the North Carolina Utilities Commission ("Commission") that no refunds of revenues from temporary rates are due under Ordering Paragraphs 50 and 51 of the Order Approving Partial Settlement Agreement and Stipulation, Deciding Contested Issues, Approving Water and Sewer Investment Plan, Granting Partial Rate Increases, and Requiring Customer Notice ("2023 Rate Case Order") entered in this docket by the Commission on June 5, 2023.

In support of this Notice, Aqua shows the following:

1. On June 30, 2022, Aqua filed an Application with the Commission seeking authority to adjust and increase its rates for providing water and sewer utility service in all of its service areas in North Carolina. Within its Application, Aqua notified the Commission of its intent to implement its proposed rates on a partial, temporary basis subject to refund, pursuant to N.C.G.S. § 62-135, effective

for service rendered on and after six months from July 30, 2022, which would be January 30, 2023.

- 2. On January 26, 2023, Aqua filed a Notice of Intent to Place Temporary Rates in Effect Subject to an Undertaking to Refund Pursuant to N.C.G.S. § 62-135 and Request for Approval of Notice and Undertaking (Notice of Temporary Rates). This request included temporary rate increases in all of Aqua's service areas.
- 3. On February 6, 2023, the Commission issued its Order Approving Public Notice of Temporary Rates Subject to an Undertaking to Refund. On February 7, 2023, the Public Staff filed a letter requesting that the Commission authorize temporary rates no earlier than February 19, 2023.
- 4. On February 7, 2023, the Commission issued its Order Granting Motion to Adjust Dates for Implementation of Temporary Rates Under Bond and Approving Revised Notices to Customers. The revised notices stated that temporary rates would be effective for service on and after February 19, 2023.
- 5. This February 7, 2023, order stated "That Aqua shall be, and is hereby obligated, to refund to its customers any amount of temporary rates made effective on and after February 19, 2023, that are finally determined by the Commission to be excessive, plus up to 10% interest per annum, and to make any refunds in a manner consistent with any additional terms and conditions imposed by the Commission in subsequent orders."

- 6. On June 5, 2023, the Commission entered its 2020 Rate Case Order in this docket. Ordering Paragraphs 50 and 51 of the 2023 Rate Case Order provide as follows:
 - 50. That Aqua shall refund all partial, temporary rates and charges in excess of the final rates and charges found to be appropriate by the Commission, if any, in the Aqua NC Water, Aqua NC Sewer, [Fairways Water, Fairways Sewer,] and Brookwood Water Rate Divisions with interest at 10% compounded annually.
 - 51. That Aqua shall file a refund plan for the excess partial, temporary rates and charges collected from the customers, if any, in the Aqua NC Water, Aqua NC Sewer, [Fairways Water, Fairways Sewer] and Brookwood Water Rate Divisions within 30 days of the date of this Order and the Public Staff shall file a response to said refund plan no later than 60 days from the date of this Order.
- 7. In its proposed interim rates, Aqua adjusted and increased the Company's then-existing rates for the Aqua Uniform Water Rate Division to produce an increase in annual service revenues of \$4,208,356; an increase in annual service revenues for the Aqua Uniform Sewer Rate Division of \$1,767,004; an increase in annual service revenues for the Fairways Water Rate Division of \$144,239; an increase in annual service revenues for the Fairways Sewer Rate Division of \$254,832; and an increase in annual service revenues for the Brookwood Water Rate Division of \$723,966. (See attached Exhibit 1 lines 1-3)
- 8. The Commission, in the 2023 Rate Case Order, approved the following increases in the Company's annual service revenues by Rate Division: Aqua Uniform Water: \$6,503,490; Aqua Uniform Sewer: \$3,429,469; Fairways Water \$742,120; Fairways Sewer \$864,692; and Brookwood Water: \$2,460,805. (See attached Exhibit 1 lines 10-12)

- 9. Thus, the annual rate increases allowed by the Commission for each of Aqua's Rate Divisions in the 2023 Rate Case Order which were subject to the interim rate increases were more than what the Company imposed and collected in its interim rates. For that reason, no refunds to customers are required.
- 10. Exhibit 1 attached to this Notice documents Aqua's position that no refunds of the temporary, interim rates collected by the Company pursuant to N.C.G.S. §62-135 between February 19, 2023 (the date Aqua put interim rates into effect), and June 5, 2023 (the effective date of the Commission's 2023 Rate Case Order) are required.

WHEREUPON, Aqua requests that the Commission enter an Order ruling that the Company has no refund obligation under the provisions of N.C.G.S. §62-135 with respect to the collection of temporary, interim rates in the present docket.
