The purpose of the Company's update is to incorporate the version of the North Carolina Interconnection Procedures, Forms and Agreements for State-Jurisdictional Generator Interconnections ("North Carolina Interconnection Standard" or the "Standard") currently in effect by reference to the North Carolina Utilities Commission Docket E-100 Sub 101, and to remove the Standard itself as an attachment to Section XXIV. This update is intended to ensure that customers can readily access the most up-to-date version of the Standard and to obviate the need for the Company to make future updates to Section XXIV as the Standard may be revised from time to time.

The North Carolina Interconnection Standard shall apply to the interconnection and/or parallel operation of a Generating Facility that is under the jurisdiction of the Commission, regardless of: 1) the size or voltage level of the interconnection; or 2) whether the Interconnection Customer is selling electricity or using the electricity produced to offset the Interconnection Customer's own electricity consumption.

The North Carolina Interconnection Standard shall not apply to the interconnection and/or parallel operation service of a Generating Facility: 1) under the jurisdiction of the Federal Energy Regulatory Commission; or 2) under the jurisdiction of the Commission that was interconnected or approved for interconnection on or before June 9, 2008, unless the Company and the Interconnection Customer agree otherwise.

The North Carolina Interconnection Standard shall apply to the interconnection and/or parallel operation of a Generating Facility that is under the jurisdiction of the Commission, regardless of: 1) the size or voltage level of the interconnection; or 2) whether the Interconnection Customer is selling electricity or using the electricity produced to offset the Interconnection Customer's own electricity consumption.

The North Carolina Interconnection Standard shall not apply to the interconnection and/or parallel operation service of a Generating Facility: 1) under the jurisdiction of the Federal Energy Regulatory Commission; or 2) under the jurisdiction of the Commission that was interconnected or approved for interconnection on or before June 9, 2008, unless the Company and the Interconnection Customer agree otherwise.
