BY THE PRESIDING COMMISSIONER: On July 2, 2018, the Commission issued an Order in the above-captioned docket that, among other things, scheduled this matter for a public witness and expert witness hearing on Tuesday, September 18, 2018. Testimony and exhibits of two witnesses, Megan W. Jennings and Veronica I. Williams, were filed by Duke Energy Progress, LLC (DEP), and affidavits of two witnesses were filed by the Public Staff.

On September 12, 2018, DEP filed a motion requesting that DEP's witnesses be excused from attending the expert witness hearing. DEP states that DEP consulted with counsel for all parties in this docket and all parties have agreed to waive cross-examination of DEP's witnesses and offer no objection to the introduction of the witnesses' testimony and exhibits into the record. Further, DEP states that DEP and the Public Staff agree that if there is not a timely request filed to cross-examine the Public Staff's affiants, the affiants' affidavits can be introduced as evidence.


Based on the foregoing and the record, the Presiding Commissioner finds good cause to excuse DEP's witnesses from attending the expert witness hearing on September 18, 2018, to receive their testimony and exhibits into evidence at the hearing, and to hold in abeyance a ruling on the Public Staff's affidavits until after the time for requesting cross-examination of the affiants has expired.

IT IS, THEREFORE, SO ORDERED.
