	TIME TO FILE TESTIMONY

BY THE CHAIRMAN: On July 14, 2017, the Commission issued an Order Scheduling a Show Cause Hearing, which, among other things, requires that the direct testimony of Frontier and other intervenors be filed by September 25, 2017.

On September 19, 2017, Frontier filed a motion for extension of time for pre-filed testimony be extended to October 2, 2017. Frontier states that it has been working diligently to fully address the compliance matters in the Show Cause Order and to allow outside counsel reasonable time to assist in the proceedings of this docket, but will not be in a position to file testimony by September 25, 2017. Further, Frontier states that the Commission Staff does not object to its motion.


Based on the foregoing and the record, the Chairman finds good cause to extend the date for Frontier to October 2, 2017.
