NOW COMES Duke Energy Carolinas, LLC (hereinafter "Duke Energy Carolinas" or the "Company") pursuant to R1-7 and moves the Commission to issue an order extending the due date for filing reply comments in the above-captioned docket, currently scheduled for March 30, 2011, five calendar days to April 4, 2011. In support of this motion, the Company respectfully shows the Commission the following:

- 1. Duke Energy Carolinas, Carolina Power and Light Company, d/b/a Progress Energy Carolinas, Inc. ("Progress"), and Virginia Electric and Power Company, d/b/a/ Dominion North Carolina Power ("NC Power") filed their initial statements and exhibits in this docket on November 1, 2010. Western Carolina University filed its Comments and Proposed Rates on October 21, 2010. New River Light and Power Company filed Comments and Proposed Avoided Cost Rate on March 2, 2011.
- The Company filed a Revised Initial Statement and Exhibits on November 29,
 2010.
- 3. On January 7, 2011, the Public Staff filed a Motion for Extensions of Time, requesting the Commission to extend the time from January 10, 2011 to February 22, 2011 for the Public Staff to file its Initial Statement and for all parties other than the electric utilities to file the comments and exhibits they wish to present in this docket. The Public Staff also requested that the time for filing reply comments be extended by a commensurate amount of time.

- 4. By Order issued January 12, 2011, the Commission allowed the Public Staff's motion and extended the time for reply comments to be filed until March 30, 2011.
- 5. On February 21, 2011, the Public Staff filed a motion for extension of time that it subsequently clarified by oral motion, requesting that due date for intervenor comments be extended until February 25, 2011. The Commission allowed the Public Staff's motion by Order issued February 24, 2011.
- 6. The Public Staff filed its Initial Statement in Response to the electric utilities' initial statements on March 1, 2011. No other party filed an Initial Statement or intervenor comments at that time.
- 7. Reply comments by the parties are presently due on March 30, 2011. Due to the press of other business, however, the Company has been unable to review the Public Staff's comments and complete its reply comments in response. Therefore, the Company seeks an extension of time for all parties to file reply comments in this docket of five (5) calendar days, up to and including Monday, April 4, 2011.
- 8. The Public Staff has contacted all parties to this docket to determine if any party objected to its proposed extension of time. As of Monday, March 28, 2011, the Public Staff has received responses from all parties except the New River Light and Power Company, Mr. Charles Mierek, and Western Carolina University. No responding party has objected to the proposed request for additional time.

WHEREFORE, Duke Energy Carolinas respectfully requests that the Commission issue an order extending the time for all parties to file reply comments in this docket and granting such other relief as the Commission deems just and proper.
