NOW COMES THE PUBLIC STAFF – North Carolina Utilities Commission, by and through its Executive Director, Robert P. Gruber, and respectfully moves the Commission for an extension of time to and including October 4, 2010, in which parties may file comments pursuant to the Commission's *Order Requesting Comments on Modifications to Rules R8-64 through R8-69 and Interim Operating Procedures for NC-RETS* issued August 3, 2010, in the above captioned dockets.

In support of this motion, the Public Staff shows as follows:

1. In its August 3, 2010, Order, the Commission invited comments on or before August 20, 2010, on its preliminary decisions regarding the parties' proposed amendments to Rules R8-64 through R8-69 in Docket No. E-100, Sub 113, and its additional amendments to those rules, as well as on procedures developed within the NC-RETS Stakeholder Group and adopted by the Commission, on an interim basis, by Order issued July 1, 2010, in Docket No. E-100, Sub 121. The Commission specifically requested comments regarding any conflicts or inconsistencies between the NC-RETS Interim Operating Procedures and the revised rules. By Order issued August 11, 2010, the Commission extended the deadline for filing these comments to and including September 20, 2010.


Therefore, the Public Staff respectfully prays:
