Dear Ms. Jarvis:

Carolina Water Service, Inc. of North Carolina ("CWSNC" or "Company"), in its capacity as Emergency Operator ("EO") of the Riverbend Estates Water System ("Riverbend"), hereby requests that the Commission approve, as new EO provisional rates, the rates attached to the Proposed Order filed on February 22, 2018, by the Public Staff in Docket Nos. W-390, Subs 13 and 14 and W-354, Sub 358.¹ Specifically, CWSNC requests approval to immediately implement the new rates for bills issued effective on and after March 13, 2018. The new proposed provisional rates are lower than the provisional rates established in the EO docket (W-390, Sub 13), and early adoption of them by the Commission brings rate relief to the Riverbend customers.

CWSNC is authorized to state that the Public Staff stipulates to the Company's rate reduction proposal applicable to EO provisional rates for bills rendered on and after March 13, 2018.

In addition, CWSNC requests that the Commission defer, at this time, taking any action on the transfer application currently pending in Docket Nos. W-390, Sub 14 and W-354, Sub 358, while the Company performs additional due
