The Natural Heritage Program database does not contain any records for federally or state protected species from within the project site itself, nor does it intersect any Dedicated State Nature Preserves, Registered Natural Heritage Areas, Significant Natural Heritage Areas, or any sites managed for the conservation of natural diversity. However, the site is located within 0.33 miles of the Fishing Creek Aquatic Habitat, which contains records for the following species of state-listed aquatic animals:

A small stream appears to drain the property into the Aquatic Habitat. We therefore recommend that all best management practices be followed, both during the construction phase of the project and during maintenance thereafter, for the control of sedimentation and runoff.

Staff has reviewed the subject documentation that proposes a ground mounted solar facility that will be interconnected to the grid operated by Duke Energy Carolinas. From the photo provided, staff could not determine the relationship of the project footprint with respect to the main stem of Fishing Creek. Be advised that the site will need to comply with Tar-Pamlico River Basin Buffer Rules (15A NCAC 02B .0260) and secure and secure 404 permits and 401 Certification if wetlands impacts are coincident to site development.
